

Install **Easy Asset Management** from the Atlassian Marketplace


Easy Asset Management consists of 2 apps so that it will work with Jira and Confluence. The next step will install the second app.







First Start and Initial Setup (2)


All Easy Asset Management data is stored to and accessed from your selected Confluence space. That means:

- No data leaves your Atlassian host. All your data is kept inside ASSETS Data-page in your Confluence space.
- All permissions and security that apply to the selected Confluence space applies to Easy Asset Management as well. You configure access to the Easy Asset Management by configuring the Confluence space
- Backup your Confluence space will also backup your Asset Management data
- If you **delete** the selected Confluence space your Easy Asset Management data is deleted as well!







Link Jira Issue to Asset (1)




3. Click on **Edit-Button**, to link an Asset

2. **Assets-View** is empty, because no Asset is linked






Settings

You can reload the app any time when you click on Reload app-Button.


If you experience any problem with the app, first try to reload the app.




Settings – Setup new Space

Select a new space and click on **Setup Space-Button** to setup and switch to a new space to store your asset management data in. This does not copy any Easy Asset Management data to the new space. It just creates a new empty one. You can use Confluence page copy tools to copy Easy Asset Management data over to the new space. All data is stored inside *ASSETS Data*-page.

No Easy Asset Management data will deleted from the old space.




Easy Asset Management (Development)



Settings – Switch to another Space

You can **switch to another space**, which contains other easy asset management data. Switching between spaces can be practical if you want to separate data and user permissions.

Right now its not recommend to have more than one space to store your Easy Asset Management data in. New features will be added to support that use case.



Easy Asset Management (Development)

Assets Settings
Setup Space
We recommend to select an empty space to store your data in. You can do so by creating a new space and select it here.
Permissions: Any user who uses Easy Asset Management needs read and write permissions to the selected space. Easy Asset Management will act on behalf of the user and thus all Confluence permissions of the user apply to Easy Asset Management.
Security & Audit: All your data is stored on your Confluence instance under ASSETS Data. All history of data changes is kept.
Spaces: You can use multiple spaces with Easy Asset Management to separate and secure access to asset management data.
