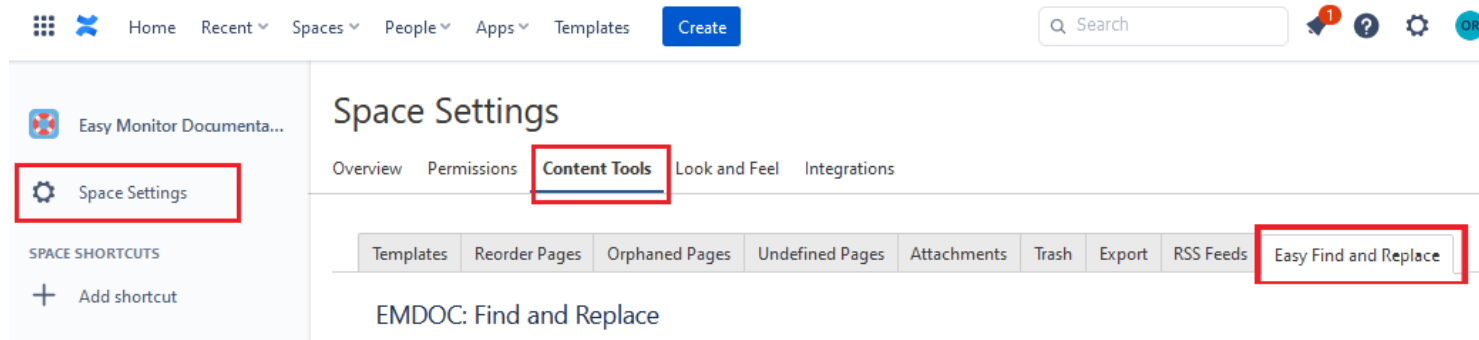

Dashboard - Overview all your **URLs**

The dashboard shows all monitored **URLs**. A green symbol shows the **URL** endpoint is responsive, while a red one visualizes a service outage. A yellow symbol indicates a partial outage or degrading service performance.

Overview over all **URLs**

Add **URLs**

Below the dashboard is a **URL** input field and a submit button to add an **URL** to be monitored. If you exceeded the **URL** limit, then the fields are hidden and a message is shown.

View **URL** Health

View Latency of an **URL**. A spike in latency troubled service availability or even no availability at the time.

Remove **URL**

Remove an **URL** by clicking on the

How to replace text in your space

Find

URL Type your search query here

Replace

link Type your replace text here

Find and Replace

← Click on **Find and Replace**
Button to do the replacement

The search result will empty itself, as more and more pages will replace the **search query** with the **replace text**.

You can verify if the replacement was successful by searching for your **replace text**.
